Each course is run for 3 consecutive weeks and caters for complete novices of all ages. Session duration is from 10.00am till about 12.30pm. We provide all archery equipment - all you need bring is a hat and sunscreen. Wear close fitting clothes and shoes, not sandals or thongs.

Once you have completed the beginners course, you should start to assess whether you wish to carry on with the sport. At this stage you may become a "Temporary Member" to be properly affiliated without having to join the Club formally. Until you have your own equipment, you may continue to use club equipment for the hire fee of \$5.00 per day.

After a couple of months, you should decide if you wish to continue with the sport and become an archer and member of our club. At this point formal membership is available.
